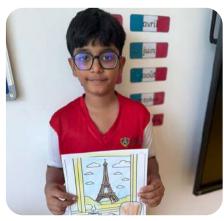




















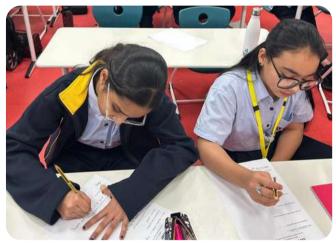




A STRONG START
