BIG SMILES AND NEW DISCOVERIES IN FOUNDATION STAGE

This week has been full of excitement as our FS children are happily settling into their classroom routines and embracing school life with big smiles! In FS1, the focus was on family. The children proudly shared their family photographs with classmates and took part in a variety of engaging activities around this theme. A highlight was creating their own family portraits, which they were delighted to display. In FS2, the children went on an emotional adventure with the story "The Colour Monster." Through this lovely book, they discovered how different colours can represent different feelings. It was wonderful to see them express their emotions with confidence and talk openly about the many feelings they experience during the school day.



















CREATIVITY, CONFIDENCE, AND CELEBRATION IN KS1

Our KS1 students have been actively exploring creativity, collaboration, and hands-on learning through a variety of engaging activities. These experiences have boosted their self-esteem, highlighted their individual strengths, and celebrated their unique qualities. It was wonderful to see them enjoy DEAR time and participate in International Literacy Day. In Year 1, children also showcased their talents during the Talent Show, while practicing forward counting through interactive activities and strengthening their phonics skills by creating CVC words with focused practice.















A DYNAMIC START TO THE TERM IN KS

Students in Key Stage 2 have made a strong start to the term. In English, they completed their baseline assessments and began exploring main ideas in reading comprehension, while in Mathematics, they wrapped up Algebraic Expressions with a Kahoot quiz before moving on to the Number System. In Science, students investigated air resistance through parachute experiments and created classification keys for living things. Humanities lessons focused on continents, oceans, and important imaginary lines. In Arabic, students began building vocabulary, mini dictionaries, and simple sentences, while French classes introduced colours, conversations, and short self-descriptions. Islamic Studies lessons covered Tajweed, recitation, and the themes of selected surahs.























LAYING THE GROUNDWORK FOR SUCCESS

KS3 Students have made a strong start to the term—completing baseline assessments, reviewing key concepts through interactive activities, and exploring new topics through hands-on learning and observation. This week, students also began building vocabulary, writing their first paragraph, completing a spelling task, and starting to construct sentences using new words. A fantastic beginning to their learning journey!













ENERGY, TEAM SPIRIT, AND PLENTY OF FUN

Students enjoyed an exciting week in PE filled with movement, teamwork, and laughter. They practised new skills, joined in friendly challenges, and discovered the joy of staying active. 


